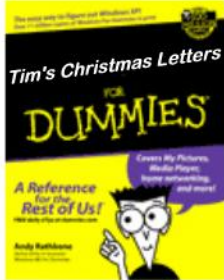


Stop!!!

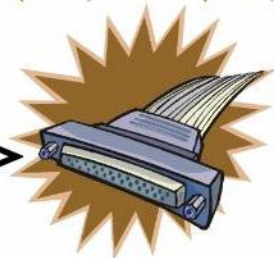
